



Crime Alert (Timely Warning) Robbery

On September 30, 2015, at approximately 6 p.m., City of Miami Off-Duty Police Officer assigned to work at the Campus informed all public safety staff that police were searching for a white male, 5'11", wearing a gator's baseball cap, long sleeve grey sweater, and grey sweat pants. The suspect was involved in a robbery at Chase Bank located at SW 8th street & 27th avenue.

MDC InterAmerican public safety staff were on high alert and Miami Police barricaded a perimeter around the incident location. The suspect is still on the run as October 1, 2015 but Miami Police Department is investigating the incident.
