



## Timely Warning to Wolfson Campus Community

The Department of Public Safety is alerting the MDC community at the Wolfson Campus that an unwanted physical contact—fondling—was reported at the campus on Tuesday, November 28, 2017.

A female student reported that between 10:00 am and 10:15 am, while she was in the stairwell of Building 1000 heading to the 5<sup>th</sup> floor, she encountered an unknown male heading towards the 6<sup>th</sup> floor. Without communicating a word, the unknown male abruptly grabbed the victim's posterior with both hands.

The suspect in this incident is described as an African-American male in his mid-20's, medium to heavy set, robust physique, approximately 5'8'' to 6'0'' tall, wearing all black clothing, a gray beanie wool hat, with a partial beard, and carrying a grayish duffel bag. It is unknown whether this individual is a member of the College community. The suspect has not been apprehended at the time of this Warning.

Reports from MDC Public Safety and the City of Miami Police were completed as a result of this incident. The Wolfson Campus is providing the alleged victim resources and support to deal with this difficult situation.

We take these matters extremely seriously and are cooperating fully with authorities. We are committed to protecting our open and welcoming campuses to ensure that students and employees enjoy a safe learning and working environment.

Students and employees are reminded to be vigilant and report any suspicious activities to the Department of Public Safety at 305-237-3100. We would like to remind you not to follow unknown persons to isolated areas and to make every attempt to always be in groups, especially when walking to and from parking areas.
