TABE REQUIREMENT

The <u>Tests of Adult Basic Education (TABE)</u> test provided by MDC satisfies this requirement. The minimum passing scores vary among the CTE programs. Students should speak with their program advisor to validate score expectations and testing exemptions. Students who complete the CTE program must meet basic skills competencies before a certificate of completion is awarded.
