An analysis of organized crime in today's society, as well as, past, present, and future perspectives of the topic.

Course Competencies:

- 3. Defining alcohol metabolism
- 4. Analyzing alcohol dependence

- 1. Defining codeine and its effects
- 2. Defining morphine and its effects
- 3. Defining methadone and its effects
- 4. Defining fontanels and its effects

Competency 4: The student will demonstrate knowledge of the effects of tobacco by:

- 1. Citing and analyzing mortality rates
- 2. Exploring the effects of smoking
- 3. Analyzing the effects of tobacco on fetus
- 4. Defining chronic illnesses resulting from tobacco use

Competency 5: The student will demonstrate knowledge of the effects of marijuana by:

- 1. Comparing the medicinal and recreational usage of marijuana
- 2. Exploring perceived risks
- 3. Identifying the availability of cannabis
- 4. Citing and describing disapproval of the legalization of marijuana

Competency 6: The student will demonstrate knowledge of the effects of inhalants by:

- 1. Reviewing the history of inhalants
- 2. Identifying the prevalence of use among teenagers
- 3. Comparing and contrasting the use and effects of inhalants by gender and race

Competency 7: The student will demonstrate knowledge of drug use within sub-cultures by:

- 1. Identifying the prevalence of drugs among athletes
- 2. Analyzing drug use among women
- 3. Analyzing drug use as it pertains to race, ethnicity and age

Competency 8: The student will demonstrate knowledge of Federal Drug Control by:

- 1. Analyzing the Drug Enforcement Agency and its function
- 2. Identifying the role of the Federal Bureau of Investigation in drug enforcement

- 3. Reviewing Immigration and Customs Enforcement (formerly Customs), relative to drug interdiction
- 4. Describing the role of the U.S. Coast Guard in preventing drugs from entering the country

Competency 9: The student will demonstrate knowledge of the Federal Drug Administration by:

- 1. Defining the regulation of drugs
- 2. Defining classification of the drug schedules
- 3. Reviewing the process for regulating new medications
- 4. Reviewing the process for regulating drug effectiveness

Competency 10: The student will demonstrate knowledge of drug treatment services by:

- 1. Analyzing the Alcoholics Anonymous organization and its purpose
- 2. Reviewing the history of drug treatment services
- 3. Defining therapeutic strategies for drug treatment
- 4. Identifying pharmacological strategies for drug treatment
