

Course Description

CJK0018 | Legal | 2.13 credits

In this course students will learn legal rules and concepts, amendments, and law. The student will learn the basics of law, civil and criminal liability. For School of Justice students only.

Course Competencies:

Competency 1: The student will discuss the law by:

- 1. Discussing law systems and case law
- 2. Identifying the role of constitutional law in protecting the rights of the community they served
- 3. Defining classifications of offenses and their penalties
- 4. Identifying Florida statutes for the purposes of documentation

Competency 2: The student will learn legal concepts by:

- 1. Identifying categories of criminal intent
- 2. Describing the standards of legal justification
- 3. Demonstrating legal requirements for search and seizure
- 4. Identifying rules and responsibilities for Florida citizens and weapons and firearms possession
- 5. Defining the laws of arrest
- 6. Identifying the legal basis for the use of force

Competency 3: The student will define liability by:

- 1. Describing the different types of liability
- 2. Identifying liability protections and sovereign immunity

Competency 4: The student will learn court basics by:

- 1. Describing the structure of Florida and federal court systems
- 2. Describing the different types of court proceedings
- 3. Defining common court orders, civil processes, and search warrants
