

Course Description

EAP0200 | Speech/Listening 2 | 3.00 credits

Students continue to develop the ability to understand frequently used words in oral contexts and understand and appropriately respond to simple phrases and questions. Prerequisite: EAP 0100; Corequisite: EAP 0200L.

Course Competencies

Competency 1: The student will produce spoken English by:

- 1. Using grammatical structures consistent with levels 1-2
- 2. Describing personal background
- 3. Describing past events with past tense "-ed" forms and common irregular verbs
- 4. Asking questions about others' past experiences and backgrounds
- 5. Using "be going to" to speak about the future
- 6. Asking questions about others' future intention

Competency 2: The student will demonstrate comprehension of spoken English by:

- 1. Spelling words and names and asking for the spelling of words and names
- 2. Listening to short discourses and identifying the topics
- 3. Taking accurate dictation of simple and compound sentences
