

Course Description

EAP0260 | Grammar Level 2 | 3.00 credits

Students continue to develop control of basic grammatical structures and statement/question patterns. Prerequisite FAP 0160.

Course Competencies

Competency 1: The student will demonstrate proficiency by:

1. Using the grammatical structures from Level 1 (See competencies for this level)

Competency 2: The student will demonstrate understanding of sentence structure, conjunctions and clauses by:

- Using simple sentences (S+V+C/objects)
- 2. Using compound sentences (but, and, or, so)
- 3. Using complex sentences with high frequency subordinating conjunctions in adverb clauses showing sequence or reason (e.g. after, before, when, because)
- 4. Using questions with WH-interrogatives

Competency 3: The student will demonstrate understanding of parts of speech and phrases by:

1. Using irregular plural nouns, count and non-count nouns, noun phrases with quantifiers (some, many, a lot of, any, much), nouns as objects, subject, object and possessive pronouns, possessive adjectives, adverbs of frequency and manner, and prepositional phrases in appropriate word order and context

Competency 4: The student will demonstrate understanding of verbs (tense and aspect) by:

1. Using active voice verbs appropriately in affirmative and negative statements, and question forms and short answers in the simple present as contrasted with present progressive; simple past of regular and high frequency irregular verbs, including there was/were; and simple future (will/be going to)

Competency 5: The student will demonstrate understanding of common modals and related phrasal forms by:

- 1. Recognizing contextualized meaning
- 2. Using will/be going to, have to/need to, want to/like to/would like to in affirmative, negative, and question forms for present and future intention
