



Course Description

EAP0300 | Speech/Listening 3 | 3.00 credits

Students develop speaking and listening skills necessary for participating in classroom discussions with an emphasis on clarification through rewording and asking questions. Prerequisite: EAP 0200; Corequisite: EAP 0300L.

Course Competencies

Competency 1: The student will produce spoken English by:

1. Using grammatical structures consistent with levels 1-3
2. Participating in classroom discussions, with an emphasis on narrating and describing situations to develop oral communication skills including fluency, idea sequencing, accuracy, vocabulary, and pronunciation
3. Asking and answering questions, rewording statements, and asking for clarification
4. Participating and making him/herself understood in role-playing, simulating simple social and academic situations

Competency 2: The student will demonstrate comprehension of spoken English by:

1. Answering questions and following directions appropriate to the level
2. Identifying the main idea and major and minor details of short oral discourse
3. Drawing conclusions, making simple predictions, and relating the content of short oral discourse to personal experience
4. Taking simple dictation of connected discourse
