

Course Description

EAP0300 | Speech/Listening 3 | 3.00 credits

Students develop speaking and listening skills necessary for participating in classroom discussions with an emphasis on clarification through rewording and asking questions. Prerequisite: EAP 0200; Corequisite: EAP 0300L.

Course Competencies

Competency 1: The student will produce spoken English by:

- 1. Using grammatical structures consistent with levels 1-3
- 2. Participating in classroom discussions, with an emphasis on narrating and describing situations to develop oral communication skills including fluency, idea sequencing, accuracy, vocabulary, and pronunciation
- 3. Asking and answering questions, rewording statements, and asking for clarification
- Participating and making him/herself understood in role-playing, simulating simple social and academic situations

Competency 2: The student will demonstrate comprehension of spoken English by:

- 1. Answering questions and following directions appropriate to the level
- 2. Identifying the main idea and major and minor details of short oral discourse
- 3. Drawing conclusions, making simple predictions, and relating the content of short oral discourse to personal experience
- 4. Taking simple dictation of connected discourse
