



Course Description

EAP0320 | Writing Level 3 | 3.00 credits

Students develop the ability to read texts on familiar and basic academic topics with an emphasis on vocabulary expansion and application of critical reading skills. Prerequisite: EAP0220.

Course Competencies

Competency 1: The student will demonstrate comprehension of texts appropriate to the level by:

1. Reading a variety of texts on familiar topics with an emphasis on vocabulary expansion
2. Distinguishing between main ideas and supporting details in simplified texts
3. Using textual clues to identify simple patterns of organization, e.g., connectors and transitions
4. Acquiring vocabulary, recognizing context clues, roots, affixes, definitions, restatements, and appositives.
5. Developing critical thinking skills when drawing conclusions from stated information, making simple predictions, and relating reading to personal experience
6. Recognizing limited cultural references
7. Enhancing English to English dictionary skills
