

Course Description

EAP0320 | Writing Level 3 | 3.00 credits

Students develop the ability to read texts on familiar and basic academic topics with an emphasis on vocabulary expansion and application of critical reading skills. Prerequisite: EAP0220.

Course Competencies

Competency 1: The student will demonstrate comprehension of texts appropriate to the level by:

- 1. Reading a variety of texts on familiar topics with an emphasis on vocabulary expansion
- 2. Distinguishing between main ideas and supporting details in simplified texts
- 3. Using textual clues to identify simple patterns of organization, e.g., connectors and transitions
- 4. Acquiring vocabulary, recognizing context clues, roots, affixes, definitions, restatements, and appositives.
- 5. Developing critical thinking skills when drawing conclusions from stated information, making simple predictions, and relating reading to personal experience
- 6. Recognizing limited cultural references
- 7. Enhancing English to English dictionary skills
