

Course Description

EAP0400 | Speech/Listening 4 | 3.00 credits

Students continue to develop speaking and listening skills necessary for participating in classroom discussions with an introduction to oral presentation and critical listening skills. Prerequisite: EAP0300; Corequisite: EAP0400L.

Course Competencies

Competency 1: The student will produce spoken English by:

- 1. Using grammatical structures consistent with levels 1-4
- 2. Participating in classroom discussions, expressing opinions and using language understood by attentive listeners
- 3. Continuing to develop oral communication skills including fluency, idea sequencing, accuracy, vocabulary, and pronunciation
- 4. Asking informational questions and asking for clarification
- 5. Participating in role-playing, simulating social and academic situations (e.g., giving advice, expressing obligation, necessity, permission and drawing conclusions)
- 6. Giving oral presentations on familiar topics (e.g., comparison, classification, process.)

Competency 2: The student will demonstrate comprehension of spoken English by:

- 1. Following orally expressed directions appropriate to the level
- 2. Using factual information to respond appropriately to comprehension questions
- 3. Taking notes on contemporary topics (e.g., news items, reports, etc.)
