



Course Description

EAP0400 | Speech/Listening 4 | 3.00 credits

Students continue to develop speaking and listening skills necessary for participating in classroom discussions with an introduction to oral presentation and critical listening skills. Prerequisite: EAP0300; Corequisite: EAP0400L.

Course Competencies

Competency 1: The student will produce spoken English by:

1. Using grammatical structures consistent with levels 1-4
2. Participating in classroom discussions, expressing opinions and using language understood by attentive listeners
3. Continuing to develop oral communication skills including fluency, idea sequencing, accuracy, vocabulary, and pronunciation
4. Asking informational questions and asking for clarification
5. Participating in role-playing, simulating social and academic situations (e.g., giving advice, expressing obligation, necessity, permission and drawing conclusions)
6. Giving oral presentations on familiar topics (e.g., comparison, classification, process.)

Competency 2: The student will demonstrate comprehension of spoken English by:

1. Following orally expressed directions appropriate to the level
2. Using factual information to respond appropriately to comprehension questions
3. Taking notes on contemporary topics (e.g., news items, reports, etc.)
