

## **Course Description**

## EAP1500 | Speech/Listening Level 5 | 3.00 credits

Students develop communication, organization, and pronunciation skills necessary for effective academic presentation and discussion with an introduction to lecture note taking. Prerequisite: EAP 0400; Corequisite: EAP 1500L.

## **Course Competencies**

**Competency 1:** The student will produce spoken English by:

- 1. Using grammatical structures consistent with Levels 1-5
- 2. Demonstrating sufficient accuracy and fluency to ensure comprehensibility in diverse social, professional, and academic situations
- 3. Producing intelligible pronunciation, stress, and intonation
- 4. Delivering prepared presentations
- 5. Explaining and supporting opinions
- 6. Giving extemporaneous presentations on diverse topics

Competency 2: The student will demonstrate comprehension of spoken English by:

- 1. Paraphrasing basic information or opinions from original sources and crediting the source
- 2. Taking notes during oral presentations and using notes to summarize the content
- 3. Recognizing and correcting his/her own verbal mistakes
- 4. Applying various listening strategies such as listening for main ideas, listening for details, making inferences
- 5. Using analytical skills to distinguish facts from opinions, make inferences, and identify the speaker's point of view
- 6. Demonstrating comprehension of figurative language
