Students develop the ability to comprehend advanced academic readings on a variety of topics. Prerequisite: EAP0420.

## **Course Competencies**

- 1. Using test taking skills
- 2. Applying personal schema to survey and predict
- 3. Identifying implicit main idea

**Competency 2:** The student will demonstrate the ability to compare the meaning and structure of academic materials by:

**Competency 3:** The student will analyze authentic reading materials by:

- 1. Using outlining, paraphrasing, and summarizing
- 2. Comparing perspectives

Competency 4: The student will enhance the ability to apply critical thinking skills when reading by:

- 1. Distinguishing facts from opinions
- 2. Making inferences
- 3. Identifying author's purpose, point of view, tone, and method of development
- 4. Understanding the use of figurative language
- 5. Synthesizing information gathered from reading in order to give an informed opinion

**Competency 5:** The student will identify common cultural references by:

1. Interpreting mainstream references
