

Course Description

EAP1600 | Speech/Listening Level 6 | 3.00 credits

Students further develop communication skills necessary for full participation in mainstream college classrooms including comprehension of extensive discourse. Prerequisite: EAP 1500L; Corequisite: EAP 1600L.

Course Competencies

Competency 1: The student will produce spoken language by:

- 1. Using grammatical structures consistent with levels 1-6
- 2. Using supra-segmentals (rhythm, stress, intonation) and extralinguistic features to convey precise meaning

Competency 2: The student will demonstrate comprehension of spoken English by:

- 1. Taking notes during academic listening activities
- 2. Applying various listening strategies such as listening for main ideas, listening for details, making inferences with growing complexity
- 3. Demonstrating analytical listening skills, including distinguishing fact and opinion, interpreting a speaker's purpose, point of view, tone, or use of figurative language
