



Course Description

EAP1600 | Speech/Listening Level 6 | 3.00 credits

Students further develop communication skills necessary for full participation in mainstream college classrooms including comprehension of extensive discourse. Prerequisite: EAP 1500L; Corequisite: EAP 1600L.

Course Competencies

Competency 1: The student will produce spoken language by:

1. Using grammatical structures consistent with levels 1-6
2. Using supra-segmentals (rhythm, stress, intonation) and extralinguistic features to convey precise meaning

Competency 2: The student will demonstrate comprehension of spoken English by:

1. Taking notes during academic listening activities
2. Applying various listening strategies such as listening for main ideas, listening for details, making inferences with growing complexity
3. Demonstrating analytical listening skills, including distinguishing fact and opinion, interpreting a speaker's purpose, point of view, tone, or use of figurative language
