Students will learn to apply the various skills gained throughout the program in a semester long immersion at an established film entertainment company. Prerequisite: FIL2480C

Course Competencies:

- 3. Complying with supervisor's instructions for achieving tasks
- 4. Demonstrating professionalism when performing tasks

- 2. Defining the various contributions of personnel in creating a film production
