

## **Course Description**

## FIL2951 | Film Festival Experience | 3.00 credits

This course is an immersive experience in a film festival. Students engage directly with films and filmmakers through their attendance to festival screenings and professional panels and discussions. Students become acquainted with a festival's organization and develop their professional skills by participating as volunteers in a multi-cultural community event.

## Course Competencies:

**Competency 1:** The students will understand the basic logistical structure of a festival organization by:

- 1. Participating in discussions with film festival professionals
- 2. Acquiring hands on experience by volunteering for the film festival
- 3. Applying understanding of festival organization by assisting in the programming of annual SEDT Film Festival

**Competency 2:** The students identify and appreciate key attributes of independent cinema by:

- 1. Attending films during a Film Festival
- 2. Critiquing films during a Film Festival through written assignments
- 3. Applying understanding of independent cinema by programming of annual SEDT Film Festival

**Competency 3:** The student will demonstrate knowledge of workplace professionalism by:

- 1. Recognizing and exhibiting professional appearance, demeanor, honesty, integrity, responsibility, initiative, respect, confidentiality, and ethical work habits
- 2. Identifying and adapting to the organization's culture
- 3. Interacting with individuals in a multi-ethnic/multicultural organizational setting
- 4. Examining and adhering to the organization's code of conduct
- 5. Recognizing the importance of ethical behavior in the workplace
