FIL4586C | Production Workshop 2 | 4.00 credits

In this upper division workshop for BAS Students in Film, Television & Digital Production students will learn to apply industry-standard post-production techniques to complete Production Workshop 1 projects. Prerequisite: FIL4585C

Course Competencies:

Competency 1: The student will apply post-production picture editing techniques by:

- 1. Organizing and preparing video materials for editing
- 2. Utilizing standard color correction, image control and manipulation techniques
- 3. Preparing various formats for output of the final project
- 4. Generating original graphics and titles

Competency 2: The student will apply post-production sound designing techniques by:

- 1. Organizing and preparing audio material for editing
- 2. Preparing ADRand Foley tracks for editing
- 3. Editing and refining audio material
- 4. Incorporating applicable music recordings
- 5. Creating an industry standard sound mix

Competency 3: The student will apply distribution techniques by:

- 1. Identifying established distribution methods
- 2. Preparing a digital press kit for distribution
- 3. Creating and managing a web site for the project
- 4. Creating a fully authored project
