MEA0334C | Medical Coding/Insurance Billing with Collections | 4.00 credits

Processing health insurance claims using procedural and diagnostic coding. The student will learn and apply current government regulations affecting third-party reimbursement. Billing, electronic claims transmission, and collection systems are emphasized.

Course Competencies:

1. Learning the origination and basics of CPT
2. Choosing the correct word from the Index
3. Learning CPT symbols
4. Learning Cod Modifiers
5. Choosing the correct code from Tabular List
