

Course Description

MUM2606 | Multi-Track Production Techniques 2 | 1.00 credit

Multi-track production technique offers students with a background in multi-track recording an opportunity to sharpen their skills in recording, mix down editing and audio production. Prerequisites: MUM 2600, 2600L. Must precede MUM 2606 and 2607.

Course Competencies

Competency 1: The student will demonstrate advanced proficiency in recording session planning by:

- 1. Identifying and documenting goals pursuant to realization of a recording project.
- 2. Creating a timeline for completion of project.
- 3. Scheduling performers and session time.

Competency 2: The student will demonstrate advanced proficiency with technology used in the multi-track recording process by:

- 1. Selecting microphones and other essential devices best suited to accomplish the logistical and aesthetic goals of the session.
- 2. Effectively operating devices in the execution of all aspects of the multi-track recording process.

Competency 3: The student will demonstrate advanced proficiency in all aspects of the multi-track recording process by:

- 1. Recording musical performances or other acoustic sound sources.
- 2. Editing recorded audio signals.
- 3. Effectively applying signal processing to achieve a desired result.
- 4. Acoustically balancing recorded audio signals.
- 5. Creating final masters suitable for commercial distribution.
