

Course Description

MUT2352 | Popular Music Arranging 2 | 3.00 credits

A continuation of Introduction to Popular Music Arranging with the addition of four-, five- and six-part writing. Concentration on scoring techniques. Prerequisite: MUT2351; corequisite: MUT2239.

Course Competencies:

- Writing advanced harmonic structures in score form for rhythm section, brass, woodwind, and strings.
- Understanding advanced notation techniques.
