

## **Course Description**

## NUR3674 | Faith Based Community Nursing | 3.00 credits

This course will provide education in faith-based community nursing to registered nurses. Students will learn the skills needed to integrate the care of mind, body, and spirit in faith-based communities. The intentional care of the spirit is part of the process in preventing and minimizing illness in a faith-based community. Prerequisite: RN with at least 2 years of experience and baccalaureate degree standing. Departmental permission required

## **Course Competencies:**

**Competency 1:** The student will describe faith-based community nursing by:

- 1. Discussing the role of faith-based community nursing in promoting health and preventing disease
- 2. Discussing the role of the faith-based community nurses promote health and prevent disease in the faith-based community

**Competency 2:** The student will relate the history of faith community nursing by:

- 1. Recalling the roots of faith-based community nursing
- 2. Comparing the mission of the faith-based community and the call to faith-based community nursing
- 3. Identifying organizations and the role they play in faith-based community nursing
- 4. Recognizing the international nursing organization for faith-based community nursing

Competency 3: The student will describe the philosophy and mission of faith-based community nursing by:

- 1. Explaining the source of the faith-based community nursing mission
- 2. Comparing the philosophy of faith-based community nursing with the personal philosophy of nursing
- 3. Formulating a personal philosophy of faith community nursing

**Competency 4:** The student will describe methods of integrating ethical, legal, confidential, and caring practices in faith-based community nursing by:

- 1. Analyzing fundamental ethical theories and principles
- 2. Examining the essential elements of ethical decision making
- 3. Determining how one's values affect decision-making
- 4. Discussing ethical questions that may be met in faith-based community nursing
- 5. Discussing case studies related to faith-based community ethics

**Competency 5:** The student will recognize the need for ongoing self-care by:

- 1. Practicing stress-reducing techniques
- 2. Identifying personal signs and symptoms of spiritual distress
- 3. Developing creative strategies for self-nurturing
- 4. Identifying a spiritual advisor for regular sharing and advisement
- 5. Utilizing journaling in personal reflection

**Competency 6:** The student will discuss appropriate methods of communication as a means of collaboration with spiritual leaders of the faith-based community by:

- 1. Identifying ways to work with spiritual leaders as a team effectively
- 2. Identifying ways to select the best and motivate committee members
- 3. Discussing activities to involve the members of the faith-based community

**Competency 7:** The student will discuss the strengths and weaknesses of the healthcare delivery system in the United States by:

- 1. Comparing healthcare with other industrialized countries
- 2. Discussing whether the present healthcare meets the needs of its people

- 3. Discussing the disparities in the health care system
- 4. Identifying ways faith-based communities may bridge the deficit gap in the healthcare system

**Competency 8:** The student will discuss the role of the faith-based community nurse in life-transforming issues as related to community members by:

- 1. Describing the terminology of grief and loss
- 2. Recognizing the need for differing approaches to the grieving process
- 3. Describing therapeutic strategies for assisting others in the grieving process
- 4. Recognizing symptoms of family violence and neglect
- 5. Describing the cycle of violence

**Competency 9:** The student will implement appropriate tools to assess faith-based community needs by:

- 1. Identifying tools appropriate to a faith-based community
- 2. Designing appropriate assessment tools for faith-based community needs
- 3. Utilizing appropriate tools for specific groups within a faith-based community
- 4. Performing spiritual assessment in a simulated situation

**Competency 10:** The student will discuss and evaluate the impact of issues relating to human justice by:

- 1. Explaining the national health goals related to faith-based communities
- 2. Discussing the effect of faith-based community nursing on the community's political, economic, and psychosocial disparities

**Competency 11:** The student will identify nursing activities and interventions appropriate for a faith-based community by:

- 1. Listing activities to meet the needs of a faith-based community
- 2. Listing any services already in place
- 3. Identifying vulnerable populations in a selected faith-based community
- 4. Discussing common characteristics of faith-based community nursing

- Formulate strategies to locate, evaluate, and apply information
