

Course Description

RTV2205C | Television Workshop | 3.00 credits

Production of TV shows from the script to the taping and the fully edited master. Includes post-production if required. This course combines learning outcomes from all previous production courses through professional-level productions. Prerequisite: TV2246C. May be repeated for credit.

Course Competencies

Competency 1: The student will demonstrate proficiency in industry standard video pre-production by:

- 1. Understanding and executing pre-production management and protocol.
- 2. Determining advanced studio lighting and audio schematics.
- 3. Analyzing and developing creative aspects of television production with crew members.

- 1. Defining crew positions and individual responsibilities for video production.
- 2. Implementing crew positions and on-set protocol in creating video productions.

- 1. Developing a workflow for editing video productions.
- 2. Utilizing editing techniques to complete video productions.
- 3. Integrating audio and color management techniques for completing video productions.
