

#### **Course Description**

# RTV2943 | Summer Television Practicum | 3.00 Credits

This course is an advanced internship with limited enrollment requiring departmental approval. Students will learn advanced directing and floor management techniques while assisting in the production of shows for Cable-TAP television, Miami-Dade County's official community access channel. Prerequisite: RTV1242C. AS degree credit only.
