TPA2233 | Main stage Production-Costumes & Makeup | 1.00 Credit

Practical experience in theatrical costuming and makeup through participation in a major theatrical production. May be repeated for credit. Prerequisite: Permission of department chairperson.

Course Competencies:

Competency 1: The student will demonstrate knowledge of various stage makeup design and application techniques by:

- 1. Researching and analyzing examples of makeup design.
- 2. Distinguishing various design and application techniques in examples of makeup design.
- 3. Assessing the effectiveness of the techniques when used.

Competency 2: The student will create stage makeup designs to suit various characters by:

- 1. Researching a specific design prompt.
- 2. Analyzing the research.
- 3. Creating the design rendering.

Competency 3: The student will execute stage makeup designs on themselves by:

- 1. Observing demonstrations of makeup application.
- 2. Applying the design from the rendering to their face using the learned techniques.
