TPP2303L | Main stage Production-Assistant Designer/Director | 1.00 credit

Practical experience in theatrical design and directing through participating in a major production. May be repeated for credit. Prerequisite: Permission of department chairperson.

Course Competencies:

- 1. Developing an understanding of the production's design and/or directorial concepts in collaboration with lead designers and/or the director.
- 2. Applying design and/or directing techniques to assigned tasks on the production.

Competency 2: The student will demonstrate technical proficiency by:

- 1. Identifying applicable design and/or directing techniques to a production task.
- 2. Applying technical skills to an assigned design and/or directing task.
- 3. Support the lead designer and/or director on technical tasks in rehearsal and production

Competency 3: The student will demonstrate professionalism by:

- 1. Identifying professional expectations for executing assistantship duties.
- 2. Applying professional expectations to all production activities.
