- **Expectations:** First Responder is a co-requisite course for the Fire Fighter Minimum Standards Program and a requirement to take the State of Florida Firefighter Certification Examination. *All hours are mandatory*. Every student who partakes in this course represents the Fire Science Program of MDC and are *required* to come to class in proper attire (polo shirts, dark or khaki colored pants with a belt, closed-toe shoes, and well-groomed). Tardiness, improper attire, and disrespectfulness are prohibited; no exceptions. These expectations are preparation for the transition into the Fire Fighter Minimum Standards Program.

Deadline for registration is the day before the first day of class!!!

NOTE: In order to register for this course, you must be an active student for the Summer 2025 term with Miami Dade College under either Fire Fighter Minimum Standards(program code: 57004) or Firefighter/EMT Combined (program code: 58000). This is a vocational credit program. **Summer 2025 term registration begins March 12, 2025.** This course is limited to the first 24 students.
