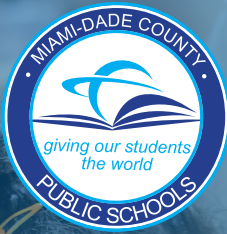


AN ASSOCIATE IN SCIENCE (A.S.) DEGREE IN EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION STARTS HERE
