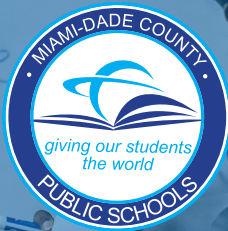


AN ASSOCIATE IN ARTS (A.A.) DEGREE IN EXCEPTIONAL STUDENT EDUCATION STARTS HERE
