INSTITUTIONAL INFORMATION FOR REVIEWERS

1. History and Characteristics

An open-access institution, Miami Dade College (MDC) enacts its vision "to be the recognized leader in student learning, achievement and success while enriching our community" by focusing on its mission to "[change] lives through accessible, high-quality teaching and learning experiences" and "[embrace] its responsibility to serve as an economic, cultural and civic leader for the advancement of our diverse global economy." MDC provides accessible and affordable learning that meets the needs of its diverse body of nearly 75,000 credit and more than 25,000 non-credit students and prepares them to be responsible citizens.

Founded in 1960, MDC was the first public institution of higher education in Greater Miami. The College responded immediately to the challenges of desegregation and, in the following years, the vast influx of Cuban refugees. In the decades since, MDC added online learning options and grew to eight campuses and two centers throughout the 2,000-plus square miles of Miami-Dade County, to provide students greater geographical access and to meet the higher education needs of the eighth largest county by population in the nation. MDC degree programs also evolved. The original Associate in Arts program continues to be the largest, but has been joined by a substantial number of Career Technical Certificate (vocational) programs, Associate in Science programs, and related College Credit Certificates. In 2002, MDC added its first baccalaureate program. The College now offers 15 baccalaureate degrees that account for 7% of total enrollment.

The College's dedicated faculty and support networks assist students to overcome what seem to be insurmountable barriers. They work while attending college (73%), are of Hispanic descent (77%), are

not native English speakers (35%), are classified as low income (68%) or live below the poverty level (47%), and are first-generation college students (58%). Yet they achieve. MDC confers more associate degrees than any other community college in the country. In 2021-22, the College awarded 15,276 degrees and certificates. Seventy-seven percent (77%) of Associate in Arts graduates transferred to Florida colleges and universities to continue their education within one year of graduation. Ninety-three percent (93) of Associate in Science and 95% of baccalaureate degree graduates found employment, including serving in the military. In 2021-2022, 60% of first-time, full- and part-time students returned the subsequent fall term after their first year.

In addition to its educational offerings, MDC provides many cultural enrichment opportunities for the local community, including the Miami Film Festival, Miami Book Fair and the historic Freedom Tower. Greater Miami and MDC students consider the College an invaluable asset that continually enriches the educational, cultural and economic lives of the community it serves.

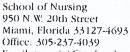
