Local Election

At MDC, we know that your vote is your voice, and this year we have two important elections, August 18th and November 3rd. On August 18th, we'll vote in the local election for Miami-Dade County Mayor, County Commissioners and other positions. These are non-partisan local races, which means anyone registered to vote can vote regardless of party affiliation.

Primary Election

August 18th is also the primary election for the Florida State Senate, Florida State House of Representatives, and the U.S. House of Representatives. Florida is a closed primary state, which means you must be registered as a Democrat or Republican to vote in the primary. The chosen candidates will then be on the ballot for the November 3rd General Election.
